

FAQs about the Engineer Visa Scheme

Question	Answer
<p>What should we do if our company does not have financial statements for the most recent two accounting periods?</p>	<p>If your company does not have the relevant financial statements, submit any document that describe your company's future business plans in as much detail as possible.</p> <p>(Examples)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If your company has a financial statement for only one accounting period, submit that statement along with your company's business plans. 2. If your company does not have any financial statements, submit your company's business plans.
<p>What kind of materials should we submit for our company profile?</p>	<p>You can submit materials that you use to introduce your company during presentations.</p>
<p>We are a temporary staffing company. Are we eligible for the scheme?</p>	<p>Temporary staffing companies are not eligible for the scheme, because they do not fall under the industrial classification specified in Section 4-1 (4) of the Outline.</p> <p>However, if your company has divisions that fall under the industrial classifications specified in the Outline, such as software development divisions, your company may be eligible to utilize this scheme to have foreign engineers work in these divisions.</p>
<p>Can we apply for the scheme while planning to establish a division that is listed in the industrial classification specified in Section 4-1 (4) of the Outline?</p>	<p>Yes, you can apply for the scheme. However, for the city to determine whether your company is eligible for accreditation, you will need to submit materials and be interviewed about the planned division, including its operation details and schedules.</p>
